

This title evocating far away countries speaks about our contemporary world and refers to a universal place of creation, right here in the midst of our utopia of building a better world, right here at the end of a dream, amidst our renunciations. We make it the generic name for a larger theatrical experience which associates a team and a company around an artistic search that we would want to be permanent and shared with the audience.


THE APPROACH

« Le Petit Théâtre du Bout du Monde is not a show like others, rather it is an experience, one of those rare and unclassifiable events that leave their marks on our memory for a long time after. Behind this title whose flavor evokes distant countries, Ézéquiel Garcia-Romeu speaks of today's world, between our renouncements and our utopias.

An allegory of an overexploited world, a poetic and theatrical performance, Le Petit Théâtre du Bout du Monde goes beyond the frontiers of space and time. As an artist of the infinitesimal, Ézéquiel Garcia-Romeu is a creator who reveals a world out of the ordinary, in a precarious equilibrium between the beauty and brutality of matter.

Here, from the outset, the Théâtre de la Massue breaks out of the mold and invites us to directly build a territory in interaction with its audience. On stage emerges a misty and uneven landscape which progressively evolves and becomes populated by puppets with sculpted faces. Here and there, these little beings get busy doing strange, sometimes absurd, tasks and participate with great care to a brilliant little machinery, immersed in this crafted universe made of wood, salvaged objects and twines. Throughout the performance, paths of hope appear amidst this emotional metaphor of our human condition.

With Le Petit Théâtre du Bout du Monde, Ézéquiel Garcia-Romeu deploys a stunning emotional force whose amazing echo with current events embraces and strikes us. »¹



THE SOUND-MATTER

The sound and music are established as sound sculpture and object, in the same manner as the characters, the scenery or the accessories, and incorporate the dramaturgy in the brutality of its immersive matter.

All the sound sources being visible, they define the outlines of the scenography as an entity owned and shared by everyone: actors-manipulators, characters and audience members.

By revealing the dramatic nature of the space, the sound object takes part in the general poetry of this artistic object.



THE AUDIENCE'S LABORATORY

Around this large game table, the audience observes and discovers that this confined world is an allegory of our reality. Inside this immersion, they soon become the intimate observers of the inner workings of this little world in crisis.

The audience can freely wander according to the short plays that manifest in this enclosed universe and can observe, as if inside an open workshop, all the mechanisms of the scenery's structure where the puppeteer himself, assuming his multiple entities, reconsiders the theatrical conventions with each of his steps.





TECHNICAL INFORMATION

Number of people on stage: 5.

Number of people on tour: 7.

Capacity: 90 people.

Set freight: 800kg, 20m³.


Assembly (sound and lighting included): 3 services.

Minimum space required: 10 meters width / 12 meters length / 5 meters height.

Stage: indoors without rows, the audience must be able to freely circulate around the apparatus. The show can also be proposed outdoors in a calm place at dusk.

Duration of the performance: 1 hour. Possibility for 2 shows per day.
